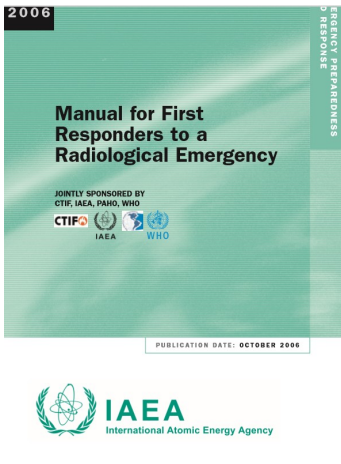

In 2006 International Atomic Energy Agency produced in cooperation with CTIF and some other agencies produced a Manual for first responders to a Radiological Emergency.

Two experts Tore Eriksson and Ove Brunnstrom from CTIF

represented HazMat Commission of CTIF and were involved in preparing this manual. After introducing it IAEA organized courses all around the world where CTIF experts were also involved as trainers.



This year IAEA decided for a revision of the document and invited 3 experts from CTIF to be involved in updating this document. They are Denis Giordan from France, Eszter Tasko-Szilagyi, Hungary and Milan Dubravac, Slovenia.

First week in March initial meeting was held in Vienna. Document will be revised until the end of September 2018 with a significant role for CTIF.

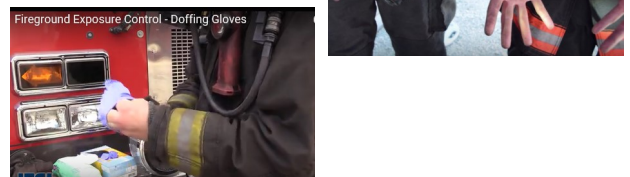
